



I. Approval of October 30, 2003 Liquid Processing and Canister Storage Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)

II. Operational Status (Roger Szelmezcza FH)

A. LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)

Waste Inventory (11/11/03)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 2.9 or 0 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 19.7 or 6.4 Mgal
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 17.4 ft or 5.3 Mgal

6 tanker shipments received during October:

- 1000 gallons purge water to Basin 43
- 8000 gallons from 105-KW Basin to Basin 44
- 8000 gallons from 105-KW Basin to Surge Tank
- 7000 gallons leachate from Mixed Waste Burial Trench to Surge Tank

EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY (ETF)

- RCRA campaign completed, preparing ETF to process Basin 43

200 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (TEDF)

- Receiving wastewater at about 5 gpm

300 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (310 TEDF)

- TEDF continues in normal operations

III. Project Specific Issues

A. Delisting Petition

1. Kathy Conaway (Ecology) reported that Ecology is in the process of finalizing the delisting petition.

B. LERF Groundwater

1. Fred Jamison (Ecology) is waiting for a response from the attorney, who has been in Washington D.C.

- C. PCB Path Forward
 - 1. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) reported that EPA has been provided the information it requested, and that approval of the RBDA for treatment and storage of the K-Basin PCB waste is anticipated by next the PMM.
- D. Status of Permit Revisions
 - 1. Roger Szelmezcza reported that a draft package of the quarterly permit modifications was provided to Ecology today.
- E. 310/340 Status
 - 1. Jeannette Hyatt reported that approval of a revised air operating permit (AOP) for the 340 stack, which is being closed, has been submitted to Department of Health (DOH). In order for the revision to be considered a minor change, the in-force notice of construction (NOC) and appealed NOC were closed, and a response is expected from the DOH that the NOCs are closed.
- F. ST4502 Permit Status
 - 1. Roger Szelmezcza reported that the addendum to the permit was submitted to Ecology for review. FH is considering other minor changes to the permit that may be requested, such as relief from sampling during low flow periods (less than 10 GPM).

 - 1. There was no discussion.
- B. 1. Kathy Conaway reported that Ecology and EPA are discussing a resolution regarding the spill that occurred at the LERF facility on October 8, 2003, mixing RCRA and CERCLA waste water.
