### 1. Approval of Past Minutes

The March Project Manager Meeting (PMM) minutes were approved.

### 2. General Discussion

- 305-B & 325 HWTUs Quarterly Permit Modifications  
E. Grohs (PNNL) reported that the 325 HWTUs Waste Analysis Plan (WAP) will be modified. The proposed modification will reflect the current waste acceptance verification testing that is performed in the HWTU. These proposed modifications are very similar to the ones that Ecology has approved at the 305B storage facility. There are still modifications at Ecology that are pending.
- RCRA Permit Renewal  
H. Tilden (PNNL) requested this topic to remain on the agenda to allow for Ecology to request any information they may need for their review process. M. Anderson-Moore (Ecology) reported that it is being reviewed and requested that all future information that is given in the RCRA Interface meetings be sent to Ecology.
- RLWS Status  
M. Anderson-Moore (Ecology) reported that Ecology is reviewing an informal copy. H. Tilden (PNNL) reported that the formal copy will be transmitted to Ecology within a day or two.
- Legacy Waste Status  
There was no status made on this agenda item.
- Discussion of Agenda Items  
T. Aldridge (PNSO) proposed this item be taken off the agenda. If there are any future agenda discussions, this item will be added back to the agenda.
- K-Basin Sludge Project  
H. Tilden (PNNL) reported work that was scheduled to take place in May was sidelined. There is project proposal write-up type work going on right now. There are no plans currently to start the work.

- Performance Track Implementation  
H. Tilden (PNNL) reported that EPA adopted a final rule for waste to be stored for 180 days. This rule was adopted approximately May 3, 2004. This rule does not take effect in Washington State unless adopted into WAC 173-303. However, during a video conference with H. Tilden (PNNL), T. Aldridge (PNSO), and Bill Glasser (EPA), EPA suggested PNNL and PNSO make efforts to work with Washington to get the 180 day rule adopted.

### 3. Action Items

T. Aldridge (PNSO) will set up a meeting with River Corridor Contractor/PNNL/DOE-RL/Ecology after September 18, 2003, to discuss the future and upcoming changes regarding the closure of the 325 Building, and Matrix information.

H. Tilden (PNNL) will provide a written response to Ecology request for further information to support a contained-in determination for 111 drums of waste.

Status: Open – Ecology is reviewing potential alternatives based on the inability of the analytical laboratory to restate its detection limits downward to demonstrate compliance with LDR treatment standards for o-cresol. (no change)
