



Public Involvement Activities for Tri-Party Agreement Change Packages for the 300 Area Waste Sites and Surplus Facilities (Tri-Party Agreement Milestone Series M-016 and M-094)

The State of Washington, Department of Ecology (Ecology), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL), hereinafter referred to as the Parties, met to determine if the changes proposed to two Tri-Party Agreement Major Milestones - M-016-00B (Tri-Party Agreement change package M-16-04-02) and Tri-Party Agreement Major Milestone M-094-00 (Tri-Party Agreement change package M-94-04-01) - meet the public comment criteria established in the Tri-Party Agreement and associated Community Relations Plan. The Parties Public Involvement Officers reviewed the subject Tri-Party Agreement change packages in accordance with the Tri-Party Agreement Action Plan, Section 10.0, *Community Relations/Public Involvement*, as well as the significance criteria within the Tri-Party Agreement Community Relations Plan and determined that the changes proposed are not significant and therefore, do not require public review. As a result, the Class I Tri-Party Agreement change packages will be approved without going through a public comment period.
