

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
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

### Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. **Approval of Past PMM Minutes**

No outstanding PMM minutes require approval.

2. **Status PMM Action Items**

None

3. **Closure Activities**

- **Phase 3 Closure (334-TF, 311-TF, WATS and U-Bearing Piping Trench)**

**Ecology Phase 3 concurrence.** In a letter to RL dated December 9, 1999, Ecology concurred with Phase 3 closure activities that were completed September 29, 1999

**PE Phase 3 closure certification.** FH (Luke) indicated that the PE certification of Phase 3 closure activities (based on the Ecology-approved Phase 3 DIP as modified at the November PMM) is underway and should be forthcoming soon.

**Reduced inspections of Phase 3 closure locations.** Based on successful completion of Phase 3 closure, a letter has been generated and should be to Ecology soon requesting Ecology approval of reduced inspections for Phase 3 closure locations.

- **Administrative Path to Completing Closure**

**Closure plan public review and approval.** The public comment period for the 300 Area WATS Closure Plan (DOE/RL-90-11, Rev 2) ended December 6, 1999. Ecology (Greta Davis) reported that two comments were received on WATS Permit conditions and that Ecology had not as yet had the opportunity to fully consider the comments. However, at first glance, the comments looked to be editorial in nature and should have little bearing on Ecology's ability to approve the closure plan.

**Append Phase 3 results to Permit.** Although 300 Area WATS physical closure activities are complete, administrative actions are still required to complete closure after the closure plan is approved. Section 6.1 of the closure plan requires that Phase 3 closure results (WRRVs and PE certification) be added to Appendix 6A of the closure plan. A Class I Modification to the WATS portion of the Hanford Facility RCRA Permit will be generated to append this information. Adding this information to the closure plan is consistent with the way Phase 1 and 2 closure

results were managed and provides the most complete closure picture to future readers.

**Modify Part A.** Section 6.1 of the closure plan requires that the 300 Area WATS Part A, Form 3 be revised to reflect closed locations and components. Also, corrections to the Part A will be made based on Ecology comments made during closure plan review.

**PE final closure certification.** Section 7.10 of the closure plan (and WAC 173-303-610) require that certification of closure be provided to Ecology within 60 days of closure plan approval. Assuming closure plan approval in March 2000, (i.e., Permit issued March 1, 2000, and effective March 31, 2000), closure certification should be submitted to Ecology by May 30, 2000. A statement of work (SOW) is in process to secure the services of a certifying PE.

#### 4. **New Business**

To save time and resources, FH (Luke) proposed ceasing regular 300 Area WATS PMMs. It was decided that the 300 Area General Topics Meeting could be used to capture WATS issues or to add WATS information to the Administrative Record. It was anticipated that individually scheduled working meetings could be necessary to complete Ecology closure approval.

#### 5. **Schedule Next Project Managers Meeting**

Future routine 300 Area WATS PMMs were cancelled.
