

**NOTIFICATION OF MILESTONES IN JEOPARDY - 90 DAY COMMITMENT**

In the letter to Tom Fitzsimmons from me, "Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order," (Tri-Party Agreement) dated March 28, 2000 (00-IPI-124), the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL), made a commitment to inform the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency of any milestones RL believes may be in substantial jeopardy of not being achieved. As stated in the letter, RL would like to work cooperatively with its regulators to change the dynamics of our interactions. In that spirit, RL has committed to voluntarily inform the regulators within 90 days of determining that completion of a milestone is in substantial jeopardy (versus 110 days before a milestone is due).

Please find attached an initial listing of Tri-Party Agreement milestones we believe are in substantial jeopardy of not being achieved. It is our intent to generate a corrective action plan or change request to bring these milestones back into compliance. Milestones which have been previously addressed in a submitted change request or are being addressed under Ecology's Tank Waste Remediation System Director's Determination of March 29, 2000, are not included in this list.


