Re: Entry of Groundwater Monitoring Information into Applicable Data Bases

Dear Mr. Morse and Mr. Erickson:

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) requested well completion and testing information for groundwater monitoring well #299-W19-23 (B8809) via an electronic mail message dated April 17, 2001. On April 19, 2001, the requested information was provided. Ecology appreciates the U.S. Department of Energy's responsiveness to the request.

In preparation for an in-depth groundwater monitoring program review of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act S-SX Waste Management Area, it was discovered that the above requested information had not been entered into the Hanford Well Information System. Similarly, the groundwater monitoring data for this well is not available via the Hanford Environmental Information System.

Due to the significance of this particular information and the immediate need by multiple users, Ecology requests the immediate entry of information into the appropriate data bases. It is very important to Ecology that this information be made available to the public.
