



310/340 PROJECT MEETING MINUTES

Project Managers Meeting

June 28, 2001

- I. Approval of the May 3, 2001 310/340 Facilities Project Meeting minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status
 - A. 340 Facility Operational Status
 1. The K-1 Exhaust HEPA filters and pre-filters at the 340 Facility were replaced on Sunday, May 6 and Monday, May 7, 2001. Preliminary results of a subsequent non-destructive analysis of the filters and prefilters indicate the filters are low-level radioactive waste and the pre-filters are transuranic waste.
 2. A video camera inspection of the 340-A Tanks was conducted on June 18th. The inspection confirmed the effectiveness of tank flushing activities conducted prior to the last load out of 340 waste in April of 1998.
 3. Work planning to perform advanced radiological characterization of the 340 Vault is proceeding.
 4. Initial efforts are underway to revise the 340 Facility Deactivation Project Management Plan.
 - B. 310 TEDF Operational Status
 1. 4,996,000 gallons of treated effluent discharged during the month of May.
 2. Ion exchange resin change out nearing completion.
 3. Permit-by-Rule analysis nearing completion.
- III. 340 Project Specific Issues
 - A. Don McBride (FH) showed a portion of a video of the 340-A Tank Inspection that was conducted on June 18, 2001. Jeanne Wallace (Ecology) requested a full viewing of the video. Chris Strand (FH) agreed to arrange for Ecology to view the video in its entirety.
- IV. 310 Project Specific Issues
 - A. 310 TEDF (Treated Effluent Disposal Facility) has not yet determined whether they are going to move forward with the Permit-by-Rule.
- V. Status of Action Items
 - A. 310/340-01-003 (750) was closed. The action was to provide Fred Jamison and Jeanne Wallace of Ecology with a 300 Area Project Management Plan (PMP) and a 340 PMP.

VI. New Action Items

- A. 310/340-01-004 – Chris Strand accepted the action to provide Jeanne Wallace (Ecology) with a full viewing of the 340-A Tanks Inspection video that was conducted on June 18, 2001.

VII. Next 310/340 Project Meeting

- A. Next meeting is tentatively scheduled for July 26, 2001.
