


- I. Approval of the July 26, 2001 616 NRDWSF Project Meeting minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status
 - A. Status of Closure Activities
 - All physical closure activities are complete.
 - Ecology walkdown of building performed on February 13, 2001, confirming visual clean closure standard identified in the closure plan were satisfied.
 - Verbal approval of draft evaluation and unvalidated soil sample data by Ecology obtained per telephone conversation on March 5, 2001.
 - Validated soil sample data transmitted to Ecology on May 9, 2001.
 - Final data evaluation and inspection checklists provided at July 26, 2001 PMM.
 - Final closure package (including professional engineer certification, and owner/operator certification) certified by FH on August 7, 2001 and transmitted to RL for certification and official transmittal to Ecology.
- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. The certified closure documents have been transmitted to DOE-RL and expect to have the final documents to Ecology by the end of the fiscal year.
- IV. General Discussions
 - A. Dan Saueressig (FH) stated that FH currently is preparing cost estimates for closure for units included in the HF RCRA Permit and wondered if it would be better to use the actual costs that have accrued during the closure activities, rather than the estimates. Since Modification E is under appeal (which included the 616 closure), the closure cost estimate will remain based on the closure plan in the approved permit. Once clean closure is approved by Ecology, closure cost estimates will no longer be prepared.
 - B. Dan Saueressig (FH) reported that the facility is currently undergoing preventative maintenance.
- V. Status of Action Items
 - A. No action items to report.
- VI. New Action Items
 - A. Dan Saueressig (FH) took the action to make sure Greta Davis was added to the closure certification document distribution.
- VII. Next Project Meeting
 - A. Next project meeting is scheduled for September 27, 2001.
