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This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

The 100-IU-1 sites involved are the 600-41, H 70 Anti-Aircraft Artillery (AAA) Site; 600-42, H 71 Anti-Aircraft Artillery (AAA) Site; 600-43, McGee Fish Farm; and 600-45, Transite and Metal Debris Pile. These sites had previously been listed in WIDS as "Deleted from the NPL" in error. This reclassification form is to document that they were cleaned up as landlord actions, not under CERCLA, and can be reclassified as "Rejected" in WIDS.

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Basis for reclassification:

These sites were cleaned up by the Department of Energy as part of landlord actions, and outside of the CERCLA process. The remainder of the Operable Unit was Deleted from the NPL in May, 1998 (Declaration of the Record of Decision for the-USDOE Hanford 100 Area, 100-IU-1, 100-IU-3, 100-IU-4, and 100-IU-5 Operable Units, 1996; and the EPA Superfund Focus Sheet for the USDOE Hanford 100 Area, May 1998).
