



3.6.1 Laboratory Selection

Laboratory selection is limited as only a few laboratories are equipped to handle mixed waste because of the special equipment and procedures that must be used to minimize personnel exposure to mixed waste. Laboratory selection depends on laboratory capability, nature of the sample, timing requirements, and cost. At a minimum, the selected laboratory must have the following:

- A comprehensive QA/QC program (both qualitative and quantitative)
- Technical analytical expertise
- An effective information management system.

These requirements will be met if the selected laboratory follows the pertinent requirements contained in the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Action Analytical Services Quality Assurance Plan, Section 6.5 (DOE/RL-94-55). The selected laboratory also can meet these requirements by having some other type of QA/QC program as long as equivalent data quality is achieved.
