- I. Approval of June 29, 2005 Liquid Processing and Capsule Storage Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH). The PMM minutes were approved.
- II. Operational Status (Roger Szelmeczka FH)
- LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)
Waste Inventory (6/11/05)
- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 4.4 ft or 0.9 Mgal
 - Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 18.0 ft or 5.5 Mgal
 - Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 18.4 ft or 5.7 Mgal
- Received 2 tanker shipments during June:
- Basin 43 received 1000 gallons purgewater
 - Basin 44 received 4000 gallons from 105-KE Basin
- EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY (ETF)
- ETF in maintenance shutdown for thin film dryer replacement
 - Facility restart scheduled for July 18
- 200 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (TEDF)
- Receiving wastewater at 18 gpm
- 300 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (310 TEDF)
- Operating normally
- 340 COMPLEX
- Recovery from May 25 flood event complete, no contamination spread found
- III. Project Specific Issues
- A. Delisting Petition
1. Kathy Conaway (Ecology) reported that EPA was to post the delisting petition in the Federal Register on August 1, 2005. However, Dave Bartus (EPA) indicated to Ms. Conaway that the posting will be delayed for a day or two. Once the delisting has been posted for 30 days, it becomes effective.
- B. Status of RCRA Permit Revisions
1. Tony Miskho (FH) stated that the revised Part A's and the LERF/ETF Class 1 permit modifications have been submitted to Ecology.

- C. 310/340 Status
 - 1. Roger Szelmeczka (FH) reported that a meeting was held to discuss Ecology's 340 LDR inspection, and RL/FH are waiting for a final written response from Ecology. Mr. Szelmeczka inquired about Ecology's response to the 340 proposed surveillance and maintenance (S&M) plan. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) responded that an internal meeting is scheduled for today to discuss 340, and that she would ensure the S&M plan would be addressed.
- D. ST4502 Permit Status
 - 1. Ms. Conaway stated that she was to meet with Johnson Control Group, RL and FH today to discuss a proposed new discharge to TEDF. However, the meeting was canceled and a new date has not been set up.

IV. General Discussions

- A. LERF
 - 1. Ms. Conaway stated that she is nearing completion of her review of the LERF permit conditions for groundwater monitoring. Ms. Singleton noted that when the permit conditions are sent to RL, there will be an opportunity to discuss and restructure some of the language of the conditions, but not to delete any of them.

V. Status of Actions

- A. 1129 - Ecology is still reviewing the permit conditions.
- B. 1321 - The permit modifications have been submitted to Ecology. This action was closed.
- C. 1322 - This action remains open.
