LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)

Waste Inventory (8/11/05)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 4.4 ft or 0.9 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 16.1 ft or 4.7 Mgal
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 18.9 ft or 6.0 Mgal

Received 2 tanker shipments during July:

- Basin 42 received 14,000 gallons mixed waste burial trench leachate (2 shipments)

- ETF restarted on August 1 and is operating at 126 gpm

1. The delisting petition is due to become effective September 22, 2005. The parties agreed to remove this item from the agenda.

1. Roger Szelmezcza (FH) stated that revisions on the waste analysis plan and Chapter 1 will be forthcoming, likely in the next quarter.

C. 310/340 Status

1. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) noted that a meeting is scheduled for this afternoon with Ecology regarding clarification of the corrective measures resulting from Ecology's LDR inspection.

D. ST4502 Permit Status

1. Mr. Szelmeczka reported that he received a brief e-mail from Kathy Conaway (Ecology) regarding her meeting with Johnson Control (JCI). There is a possibility the ST4502 permit renewal date will be impacted by JCI's proposal to add two boilers to the waste stream.
