Cleanup of the Hanford Site 324 and 327 Buildings

This is advanced notice that the Tri-Party Agencies will be seeking comments on the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis #2 for the 300 Area, DOE/RL-2005-84. The purpose of this engineering evaluation/cost analysis (EE/CA) is to evaluate alternatives for final disposition of the 324 and 327 buildings, and ancillary facilities located in the 300 Area of the Hanford Site. The 324 and 327 Buildings were used to perform chemical processing and metallurgical engineering studies on highly radioactive materials and to develop approaches for waste treatment and storage. Major operations have ceased in both buildings.

The 30-day public comment period is expected to run February 27 – April 3, 2006.
