






I. Approval of September 22, 2005 Liquid Processing and Capsule Storage Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH).

LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)

Waste Inventory (10/09/05)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 4.8 ft or 0.9 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 12.7 ft or 3.3 Mgal
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 19.0 ft or 6.0 Mgal

Received 27 tanker shipments during September:

- Basin 42 received 29,000 gallons leachate from the mixed waste trench
- Basin 44 received 84,000 gallons from 105-KW Basin
- Basin 44 received 1000 gallons purgewater from well 299-W23-19

A. Status of RCRA Permit Revisions

1. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) reported that Kathy Conaway (Ecology) is finalizing the permit language regarding the LERF groundwater monitoring, which will then undergo a review by Ecology's hydrogeology staff.

B. 310/340 Status

1. Greg Sinton (RL) reported that discussions are ongoing regarding resolution of Ecology's LDR notice of noncompliance and corrective measures. RL/FH has drafted a letter, and the intent is to complete a letter exchange with Ecology by November 24, 2005.

C. ST4502 Permit Status

1. There was no new status to report regarding Johnson Control's (JCI) proposed addition of waste streams. Oscar Holgado (RL) will provide an update to Roger Szelmezcza (FH).
