Dear Mr. Klein:

In the referenced letter, the United States Department of Energy petitioned to revise the existing
NOC Approval Order DE04NWP-001. Ecology reviewed the Notice of Construction (NOC)
Application under Chapters 173-400 and 173-460 Washington Administrative Code (WAC) and
finds it complete.

This letter issues approval for the petitioned revision with amendments described below.

The following Order amendment changes are approved and ordered as
Order No. **DE04NWP-001, Amendment 1:**

Change 1: Append Specific Approval Conditions as:

- 2.1 D. Actions conducted under Comprehensive Environmental Response,
Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) approval and control are not process
actions or uses for the purposes of this Order.
- 2.1 E. Process actions resulting in the emissions of polychlorinated biphenyl from paint
sources will not exceed the SQER.
- 2.1 F. Process use of Rad Pro 100 decontamination solution (identified as
decontamination solution #1 of Table 2, Section 5, of your Application) is
enjoined and may not be applied without petition and approval of specific
acceptable emission standards for ethylene glycol monobutyl ether.




