


EXTENSION OF DOE RESPONSE TO EPA/ECOLOGY COMMENTS AT THE
PROJECT MANAGERS LEVEL HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT
AND CONSENT ORDER TPA-CN-151 MODIFICATION TO THE SITE-WIDE
INSTITUTIONAL CONTROLS PLAN PER 221-U RECORD OF DECISION
COMMITMENT FROM JUNE 15, 2006 to JULY 15, 2006

The Parties agree that an extension to the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Section 9.2, Document Review and Comment Process for the U. S. Department of Energy to respond to the regulators comments for TPA-CN-151 is appropriate. The U. S. Department of Energy provided the regulators with TPA-CN-151 on April 17, 2006. The regulators responded with comments on May 12, 2006. A 30 day extension is required to allow DOE time to adequately address the regulator comments.

This extension agreed to by the Parties will be for 30 days beginning June 15, 2006 to July 15, 2006.
