Dear Mr. Klein:

This letter is to communicate the results of an inspection on the diesel-fired equipment at the Hanford 336 Building. This inspection was conducted on February 8, 2007, by the Department of Ecology. This equipment is regulated under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-400 and WAC 173-460, and permitted under Order DE06NWP-002 (Reference 1).

This facility was selected for inspection following an inspection on November 28, 2006, (Reference 2), which observed that the leased diesel-fired equipment permitted under Order DE06NWP-002 was not present at the time of inspection.

We are pleased with the level of coordination and cooperation achieved with the conduct of this inspection. All information requested was available during the inspection. We find the Hanford 336 Building to be in compliance with the Notice of Construction Approval Order requirements.
