SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS PLAN (SAP) FOR SUPPLEMENTAL REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION ACTIVITIES AT MODEL GROUP 5, LARGE AREA PONDS, WASTE SITES, DOE/RL-2006-57, DRAFT A

The purpose of this letter is to transmit the SAP for Supplemental Remedial Investigation Activities at Model Group 5, Large Area Ponds, Waste Sites, DOE/RL-2006-57, Draft A for your review and information. 0072351

The overall goals of this SAP are to collect supplemental data from the following eight waste sites: 216-A-25 Pond, 216-B-3 Pond, 216-S-16 Pond, 216-S-17 Pond (and associated UPR-200-W-124), 216-T-4B Pond, 216-U-10 Pond, and the 216-U-11 Ditch. The data collection activities are generally limited to gathering data at sites where the information has potential to impact final remedy selection (e.g., reduce institutional controls, impact barrier requirements, allow evaluation of partial excavation alternative).
