CONTRACT NO. DE-AC06-96RL13200 - INCONSISTENCIES BETWEEN THE TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT (TPA) M-015 AGREEMENT, THE HANFORD FACILITY RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY ACT (RCRA) PERMIT, AND THE TPA ACTION PLAN

The purpose of this letter is to respond to your January 31, 2007 (FH-0700205) letter requesting RL direction regarding inconsistencies between the Hanford Facility RCRA Permit (Permit) and the TPA. RL agrees with FHI that in order to fully incorporate the intent of the M-015 Agreement language, the Hanford Facility RCRA Permit and the TPA Action Plan language must be clarified. Therefore, this letter requests that FHI prepare a Permit modification and a TPA change notice in order to resolve the inconsistency created by the M-015 package.

Please include all the necessary updated information and agreements that have transpired since the M-015 Agreement was signed, and submit the information to RL for transmittal to the regulatory agencies.
