



## PURGEWATER PROJECT MEETING MINUTES

- I. Approval of April 26, 2007 Purgewater Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH). The PMM minutes were approved.
- II. Operational Status
  - A. In April 2007, there were 21,000 gallons of purgewater delivered to ETF, and 8,700 gallons of purgewater delivered to Modutanks.
  - B. Sediment within the Modutank continues to accumulate. Low cost technology options are being identified for evaluation. Can speak to this at the PMM if so desired. Nothing more to report.
- III. Project Specific Issues
  - A. Strategy Document Status
    1. Tony Miskho (FH) has been working with Ecology to resolve issues and answer questions regarding the contained-in documentation.
  - B. Purgewater Sediment Issues
    1. John Winterhalder (FH) stated that he reviewed the sample data taken last year for the water and sediment in the pond, and he is considering the possibility of developing a new sampling plan that would provide defensible, analytical results for the sediment. Mr. Winterhalder noted that the NOC is an issue. Even though there is no rad associated with the materials in the modutank, there may be some nonrad present that the materials couldn't be free-released. Mr. Winterhalder stated his preference for approaching sediment removal as a maintenance type of activity. As noted in the operational report, other low-cost options continue to be considered.
- IV. General Discussions
  - A. There were no general discussions.
- V. Status of Actions
  - A. 977 - Formally transmit the Modutanks closure plan package to RL. There was no change in status.
  - B. 1513 - Schedule a meeting with Ecology to discuss incorporation of EPA's comments on the Purgewater strategy. EPA's comments were resolved in April, and it was agreed to close this action.
- VI. New Actions Items
  - A. There were no new actions generated.

VII. Documents for submittal to the Administrative Record
