- 2706-T Building Notice of Construction (NOC) Upgrade
 - The 2706-T Building currently has a minor stack license with a limit of just 2.9 DE-Ci per year. With increased waste processing expected at the T Plant Complex, the 2706-T Building will be upgraded to a major stack.
 - Subcontractor hired to draft NOC application.

III. Project Specific Issues

- A. LDR Storage Assessment
Tony Miskho (FH) reported that a meeting is scheduled next week for comment response on the LDR assessment.

IV. General Discussions

- A. Mike Collins (RL) reported that T Plant may be receiving about 2 ½ cubic meters of backwash that was associated with the NLOP sludge from K Basins in October 2007. The waste won't be treated for several years because of focus on the TRU repackaging.
- B. The roof upgrade demolition is complete, and placement of the new roof should start in a couple weeks. There is an issue with the tie-downs that are used for workers on the roof.
- C. Regarding the fire protection, hydro testing of the sprinklers in 271-T is ongoing, and the sprinkler system should be operational within two weeks. The fire alarm panel upgrade is scheduled for completion by the end of September 2007.
- D. Bids have been received for the covered storage pad, and the goal is to have the pad completed before this winter. Steve Szendre (Ecology) requested a monthly status on the pad.
- E. Mr. Miskho reported that the Part A has been converted into the new format and a draft has been submitted for Ecology review. Mr. Miskho noted that there were waste codes change that needed to be made; W001 to WPCB, and that U121 needed to be deleted.
