SUBMITTAL OF INSTALLATION AND OPERATIONS ACTIVITIES SCHEDULE FOR SINGLE-SHELL TANK RETRIEVAL EXHAUSTERS APPROVED BY WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY APPROVAL ORDER DE05NWP-002, REVISION 3

Reference: Ecology letter from J. A. Hedges to S. J. Olinger, ORP, "Approval of Criteria and Toxic Air Emissions Notice of Construction (NOC) Application, Hanford Single-Shell Tank Waste Retrieval," dated July 31, 2007. *0073585*

In accordance with Approval Condition 2.2 of the Reference, which states, "A schedule of installation and operation activities for these exhauster systems shall be submitted within 30 days of original issuance of this ORDER with a duration extending to 12 months after the effective date of this ORDER," the following schedule of installation and operation activities is provided to the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection.

Listed below is the exhauster ventilation system installation and operation schedule. The time duration for this will be from November 1, 2007, to October 30, 2008.

- 296-P-43 500 Cubic Foot per Minute (cfm) capacity exhauster will be inactive.
- 296-P-44 500 cfm capacity exhauster will continue with operations of the retrieval of 241-S-102, which is scheduled for potential restart in June 2008.
- 296-P-47 1,000 cfm capacity exhauster will continue retrieval operations at both 241-C-108 and 241-C-109 (a single-shell tank at a time) restarting in late January 2008.
- 296-P-48 500 cfm capacity exhauster will support equipment removals at 241-C-104 tank starting in late October 2007 and tank retrieval in March 2008.
- 296-P-49 and 296-P-50 3,000 cfm capacity exhausters will not be used during the period up to October 30, 2008.
