Attached is the electronic copy of the draft Deep Vadose Zone Treatability Test Plan (DOE/RL-2007-56, Draft A) for the Hanford Central Plateau. Copies were transmitted to EPA, Ecology, Tribes, Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) and the Hanford Advisory Board (HAB). A key aspect of this plan is an upfront 90-day informal review period (January through March 2008) in which the U.S. Department of Energy is actively seeking input on the plan from regulators, Tribes, stakeholders, ODOE and the HAB. **A workshop is scheduled for February 19, 2008 to facilitate this process. The workshop will be held from 1:00 to 4:30 in room 142 of the Federal Building in Richland Washington.**
