Request for Public Comment on:

PLANS TO CLEAN UP GROUNDWATER NEAR THE COLUMBIA RIVER

The Tri-Party Agencies want your comments on proposed plans for cleanup of two groundwater sites (100-HR-3 and 100-KR-4 Operable Units) located in the 100 Area on the Hanford site.

The preferred alternative presented in the proposed plans is to pump out contaminated groundwater, treat it to reduce the concentration of chromium, and inject the treated water back into the ground. This alternative would protect the Columbia River environment. A pilot project has successfully been reducing chromium from groundwater near these two sites for the past year.

All comments will be considered by the Hanford Cleanup Agencies before an

interim record of decision is issued. Public meetings are not being scheduled but may be requested by calling the Hanford Cleanup Line. Comments on the proposed plans will be received through October 25, 1995.
