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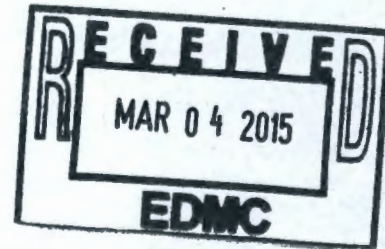

**REMOVAL FROM SERVICE OF WASTE SAMPLING AND CHARACTERIZATION FACILITY EMERGENCY GENERATOR (600 E WSCF 001)**

In accordance with Section 5.8 of the Hanford Site Air Operating Permit (AOP), Number: 00-05-006, Renewal 2, Revision A, a written notice for permanently shutting down emission units is required to be sent to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology). This letter provides notification that the Waste Sampling and Characterization Facility (WSCF) emergency generator (600 E WSCF-001) has been removed from service in conjunction with cessation of laboratory operations at the facility. There are no plans to operate the emergency generator in the future. In accordance with AOP Standard Terms and Conditions 5.8.1, periodic monitoring (i.e., at least once per calendar quarter) for visible emissions will no longer be performed as required by the Hanford Site AOP 00-05-06, Attachment 1, Table 1.4. The unit has been electrically isolated from automatic start-up at the motor control center within the facility and at the unit itself.



## NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE NOT REQUIRING PERMIT REVISION

### Section 502(2)(10) Change\*

This notification is provided to the Washington State Department of Ecology, Washington State Department of Health, and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as notice of a change not requiring permit revision described as follows.

This change is allowed pursuant to WAC 173-401-722(1), WAC 173-401-722(2) and WAC 173-401-722(5):

1. Change is not a Title I modification.
2. Change does not result in emissions that exceed those allowable under the permit, whether expressed as a rate of emissions, or in total emissions.
3. Change does not alter permit terms that are necessary to enforce limitations on emissions from units covered by the permit;
4. Notification is proved to Ecology, WDOH, and EPA at least 7 days before making the change, and
5. Change does not violate applicable requirements or contravene enforceable permit terms and conditions that are monitoring (including test methods), recordkeeping, reporting, or compliance certification requirements.

There will be no future emissions from the unit.  Waste Sampling and Characterization Facility (WSCF) emergency generator (600 E WSCF-001) has been removed from service in conjunction with cessation of laboratory operations at the facility. There are no plans to operate the emergency generator in the future. The unit has been electrically isolated from automatic start-up at the motor control center within the facility and at the unit itself.

All permit terms and conditions of the AOP will no longer be applicable.
