**Description of current waste site condition:**

This site consists of two sanitary waste holding tanks that serviced the trailers located near the top of Gable Mountain. This two sanitary waste holding tanks supported the mobile office trailers that were located on the tunnel bench for the Near Surface Test Facility. The tanks each had a 3,785-liter (1,000-gallon) capacity and were emptied every other week. This facility has been decommissioned and reclaimed.

**Basis for reclassification:**

The two sanitary waste holding tanks were removed from the site. All decommissioning and reclamation work at the Near Surface Test Facility was completed on March 23, 1988.
