
This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

The area was covered with plastic and decontaminated to 2,000 disintegrations per minute. The total contaminated area was reported as 0.6 meters by 1.8 meters (2 feet by 6 feet). The occurrence report indicates that the remaining contamination could become smearable when the ground thawed, and so was covered and contained with plastic and roped off. The final cleanup report is not available, but the site can no longer be located, indicating that the remaining contamination was removed so the posting could be removed.

Basis for reclassification:

The release is documented on Off Normal/Radiation Occurrence report 12-85-80. UPR-200-W-91 contaminated an area of ground on the north side of the 234-5Z Building. The release site was covered with snow and ice, so it was contained with plastic and roped off until it could be decontaminated. The final decontamination record could not be found. It is not currently marked or posted.
