CLOSURE CERTIFICATION FOR THE 2727-S NONRADIOACTIVE DANGEROUS WASTE STORAGE FACILITY (S-2-5)

Enclosed is a completed Closure Certification for the 2727-S Nonradioactive Dangerous Waste Storage (2727-S NRDWS) Facility. This certification has been signed by an independent, registered professional engineer (PE); by the Westinghouse Hanford Company (WHC) as facility co-operator; and by the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) as facility owner/operator. These signatures certify that closure of the 2727-S NRDWS Facility was implemented in accordance with the specifications of the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) approved and modified closure plan. This certification is required by Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-303-610 (6) and was prepared in accordance with Section 4.7 of the 2727-S NRDWS Facility Closure Plan and Condition V.3.B.f of the Hanford Facility Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit.

The 2727-S NRDWS Facility was located in the 200 West Area of the Hanford Site. This unit operated from 1983 until 1986 as a RCRA treatment, storage, and/or disposal (TSD) unit for the storage of containerized, nonradioactive dangerous waste. Closure activities were completed in 1992 in accordance with the closure plan and included unit demolition, waste removal, and closure verification soil sampling and analysis. In a letter dated January 31, 1995, Ecology determined that closure activities had achieved cleanup levels that qualify this site for clean closure. Therefore, we request that Ecology inform the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Resource Conservation Recovery Information System that this TSD unit is now "closed". We also request the reissuing of the Part A Permit Application, Form 3, with "CLOSED" stamped on it along with the date that Ecology responds to this letter.


