The soil gas sampling involving the gas chromatograph (GC) is complete. A draft report on the GC analysis is expected to be available on or around the first of October 1993 for RL review. A final report should be available by December 1993.

4. **New Business:**

Kennewick-Ecology (Mr. C. O. Ruud) stated that Ecology would provide Notice of Deficiency (NOD) for the NRDWL within 90 days of this Unit Managers meeting (September 16, 1993). Kennewick-Ecology stated further that the records from the Lacey-Ecology office have been obtained and are currently being reviewed. Kennewick-Ecology reiterated that the NRDWL would be given a high priority status and that progress would therefore start being made on this closure plan. Based on the list of items and the earlier transmitted documents Kennewick-Ecology stated that a position concerning Landfill versus Clean Closure needs still to be formalized, within Ecology. RL discussed that no NOD response have been received from Ecology since the plan was transmitted in August of 1990 and in order to proceed formally with NRDWL negotiations all comments on the plan should be made in the form of NOD.

The next UMM is scheduled for October 18, 1993, in Richland, Washington.
