This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

**Description of current waste site condition:**

This unit is a two-chamber tank. The tank has an associated drain field and a capacity of 3,500 liters (927 gallons) per day. The 2607-E11 Septic Tank and associated drain field were designed to accept sanitary sewer effluent from the 2400-E Building, the Transportable Grout Facilities, MO-385, MO-386, MO-354 and the Dry Materials Receiving and Handling Facility. This project was abandoned and it's associated buildings are no longer occupied.

**Basis for reclassification:**

The system is closed. The system was abandoned in 1997 in accordance with Washington Administrative Code 246-272-18501. It was replaced by a new regional system. It is recommended this site be reclassified to Closed Out. Washington Administrative Code 246-272-18501 does not require any additional notifications.
