


Independent Review Panel

The Independent Review Panel (IRP) requests your input on the K Basin Spent Nuclear Fuel Project regulatory strategy. This strategy is designed to achieve Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) nuclear safety equivalence for the design and construction of new fuel storage and conditioning facilities at Hanford.

The three members who make up the IRP were chosen for their regulatory expertise and their backgrounds in the nuclear industry. The IRP was established by the Department of Energy's Richland Office to provide a panel of experts who can oversee implementation of the regulatory strategy.
