Folks,

While I agree with the contents of the 1100 Area PAD transmittal letter, the issue of who should receive the letter needs to be discussed before sending the letter. There are two issues related to the letter that concern me.

First, two of the eight designated Hanford trustees (i.e. Dept. of Commerce and the State of Oregon) have no resources affected by releases within the 1100 Area. It therefore makes no sense to send them a letter to use in making a determination that they are not authorized to make. Second, the statute of limitations has expired for DOE, DOI and the State of Washington. While they could still make a determination, they can't pursue damages.

It was always my impression that the letter would only go to those trustees still able to pursue damages/restoration (i.e. the tribes). Since the transmittal letter does not address or clarify either of the issues I've raised, my concern is that we are on the verge of taking an action that is inappropriate and will lead to confusion. It may also make us look somewhat inept.

This issue is on the agenda for tomorrow and needs to be discussed before any further action is taken.
