





T PLANT PROJECT MEETING MINUTES

July 26, 2001

- I. Approval of the June 28, 2001 T Plant Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)

- II. Operational Status
 - Received 2 boxes of low-level waste from Tank Farms
 - Received 5 boxes of low-level waste from 222-S
 - Received 36 TRU drums from CWC
 - Shipped 10 boxes of low-level waste
 - Shipped 1 drum of PCB waste
 - Shipped 47 TRU drums to CWC
 - Shipped 4 drums of low-level waste to CWC
 - Shipped 1 Cell 11-L sample to 222-S for radiological analysis
 - 6 100-K waste boxes repackaged
 - 36 TRU drums head space gas sampled
 - 8 waste boxes RTR verified
 - 11 TRU drum lids RTVed
 - 2 new greenhouses erected in 2706-TA
 - 2 Canyon mixed waste boxes overpacked
 - Planning for Pre-Filter change out continues
 - Work continues on developing a sampling and analysis plan for Cell 11-L
 - Work continues on developing a sampling and analysis plan for cell clean out in support of K-Basin Sludge storage
 - Work continues on size reducing the two remaining PUREX towers in the 221-T Canyon
 - Management self assessment for operational readiness review (ORR) for PWR fuel removal continues, contractor ORR scheduled to commence in August 2001

- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. Sample Analysis Plan for 11-L
 1. Bob Barnettlor (FH) reported that the due date for the Off-Normal Occurrence Report is at the end of August.
 2. T Plant has started a Root Cause Analysis and determined that there was a loss of configuration control in the inventory of the cells sometime in the past.
 3. T Plant will generate an NTS Report.
 4. T Plant will identify and implement a corrective action.

IV. General Discussions

- A. Bob Barmettlor (FH) reported that T Plant has a goal of cleaning out four cells this year. The facility is, however, running into resources problems. Heat in the 221-T Canyon is also a factor causing the workers to only be able to work in the canyon for very limited amounts of time.
- B. Bob Barmettlor reported that the changeout of the pre-filters is on schedule for mid-September.
- C. The facility is preparing for its annual crane outage in October.
- D. T Plant is currently working with Spent Nuclear Fuel (SNF) to prepare the facility for sludge receipt.
- E. Michael Collins (RL) provided a status report on M-91 milestones related to T Plant.
