(SST) SYSTEMS FOR M-23-25D


This letter is to inform the State of Washington Department of Ecology that DOE has completed the installation of four LOWs that were installed in the SST System required by the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order, Milestone M-23-25D. The LOWs were placed in the following tanks:

- SX-111 was installed on July 23, 2003;
- T-105 was installed on August 12, 2003;
- B-109 was installed on August 21, 2003; and
- B-101 was installed on August 22, 2003.

As required per the milestone, liquid level monitoring has begun.
