




I. Approval of the June 28, 2001 200 LWPF Project Meeting Minutes
(Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)

II. Operational Status

242-A Evaporator

Evaporator is in Shutdown mode

Liquid Effluent Retention Facility (LERF)

Waste Inventory (7/18/01)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 8.1 ft or 1.8 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 15.3 ft or 5.2 Mgal
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 17.7 ft or 5.2 Mgal

UP-1 pump will be shut down about 1 week in July during power outage at Basin 43 to support Project W-519 (WTP tie-in to LERF)

Wastes received in LERF during June:

- Basin 42 received 500 gallon tanker of wastewater from HEHF on 6/11/01
- Basin 42 received 14,400 gallons of leachate by tanker from mixed waste burial trench on 6/7 and 6/19/01
- Basin 43 received UP-1 groundwater by transfer line at about 50 gpm during June
- Basin 44 received 7000 gallons of 116-N3 pipeline wastewater by tanker on 6/21 and 6/28/01

200 Area Effluent Treatment Facility (ETF)

ETF is shutdown for 3 week maintenance outage

- Replace thin-film dryer rotor with rebuilt rotor
- Sulfuric acid product tank repairs
- Evaporator boiler repairs

200 Area Treated Effluent Disposal Facility (TEDF)

- June monthly flows:
Total discharge: 3.2 Mgal
Minimum daily flow: 14 gpm (6/8/01)
Maximum daily flow: 260 gpm (6/27/01)

III. Project Specific Issues

A. Delisting Petition

1. Jamie Granger (FH) reported that all parties are meeting fairly routinely and the last meeting was held on July 25, 2001.
2. Verification sampling concepts were discussed at the last meeting.
3. FH is targeting an internal draft of the Delisting Petition by August 16, 2001. FH expects to share the draft with Ecology and EPA by the end of August.
4. At the July 25, 2001 meeting, a decision was made to keep the Waste Treatment Plant (WTP) as part of the delisting petition if the stream(s) could meet 200 Area LWPF waste acceptance criteria.

B. LERF Groundwater

1. On July 25, 2001 a meeting was held with DOE-RL, Ecology and the facilitators to structure expectations for a workshop agenda. The workshop is expected to take place July 30 and is a facilitator-directed workshop. Senior management from Ecology, DOE-RL and FH will attend the kick-off meeting.

C. PCB Pathforward

1. The PCB Strategy Team Meeting was cancelled for this week.
2. It was reported that by the end of the calendar year, there should be an approved document in place for the treatment of PCBs of various waste streams.

D. Status of Permit Revisions

1. FH reported that there will be a Class I modification prepared for the next quarterly submittal.

IV. General Discussion

- A. Kathy Conaway (Ecology) reported that the Tritium Monitoring Plan comments from Ecology will be going out in the mail next week.
- B. Glenn Richardson (DOE-RL) reported he will be leaving the organization. He introduced Grant Baston (DOE-RL) who will be sharing Glenn's duties with Kevin Leary (DOE-RL).

V. Status of Action Items

- A. LWPF-00-004 (561) remains open. The action is to schedule a meeting with D. Bartus (Ecology) to discuss the Delisting Petition. Meetings are currently being held and the action is ongoing.
- B. LWPF-00-018 (709) remains open. The action is to continue to determine groundwater options for monitoring at LERF. Meetings are currently being held and the action is ongoing.
- C. LWPF-00-019 (721) remains open. The action is for Ecology to provide a response to the SALDS Tritium Monitoring Plan. The action is ongoing.
- D. LWPF-01-023 (752) was closed. FH had the action to forward Kathy Conaway (Ecology) information related to the LERF/ETF receipt of waste

stream from 116-N. Roger Szelmeczka (FH) provided the information to Kathy.

- E. LWPF-01-023 (752) was closed. Kathy Conaway (Ecology) had the action to issue a letter granting a 180-day extension to the temporary authorization. FH is in receipt of the letter.

VI. New Action Items

- A. LWPF-01-024 – Jamie Granger (FH) accepted the action to provide a tentative schedule of dates for the Delisting Petition commitments.

VII. Next 200 LWPF Project Meeting

- A. Next meeting is scheduled for August 30, 2001.
