




 - Non-ATG Waste Accepted at Trench 34 in October

 - Waste Shipped from ATG to Trench 34 in October
Non-Thermal Treatment
MLLW 1201 cubic feet 163 drum eqs
 - 3 Defueled Reactor Compartments Received in October
- III Project Specific Issues
 - A Status of Part B Permit Application
 - 1 Dan Saueressig reported that delay of receipt of Ecology comments could impact the workshop schedule, which are due to end January 24, 2003. Matt Mills (Ecology) reported he is working on the Groundwater Monitoring Plan, and that the WAP and the Training Plan are in peer review. All comments will be submitted in one package. Mr Mills stated they would need to discuss extending the workshops' scheduled end date.
 - B Status of Carbon Tetrachloride Issue
 - 1 Monitoring is being conducted to support remediation efforts. Permanent probes will be placed to monitor the carbon tet levels.
