Subject(s) Discussed/Summary of Discussions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Cook called to inquire whether the TWRS EIS was analyzing the "sugar reduction" approach (calcination to reduce waste to the carbonate form). I told him that I personally didn't know whether this technological approach was a component of one of the EIS alternatives that was being analyzed because my group (the Natural Resources analysts) had not yet received the detailed engineering data on each of the EIS alternatives for our impact analysis. I suggested that he contact Carolyn Haas and/or Bill Glover to pursue this question further if he so desired. 	
Issues/Concerns Identified: (Unresolved questions) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Cook feels the sugar reduction has some favorable features that merit consideration. The overall issues of EIS scope and nature of the alternatives, as well as the Tribes' involvement in the EIS process are involved.
