This letter transmits the results of an inspection conducted October 25, 2008, by the Department of Ecology of Hanford Site air emission sources regulated under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-400, WAC 173-401, and WAC 173-460.

The Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant diesel-fired fire pumps were inspected based upon advice of initial operations and testing of this equipment under Order DE02NWP-002 and Air Operating Permit (AOP) Number 00-05-006. We find the facility operations to be in compliance with AOP and Order DE02NWP-002 requirements.
