This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

**Description of current waste site condition:**

The site is an unplanned release of less than 208 liters (55 gallons) of solvent refined coal due to failure of a corroded container. All discolored soil was removed shortly after the release. The release occurred in July 1986. No occurrence report was written. The exact location of the spill has not been determined.

**Basis for reclassification:**

The discolored soil was removed from the site. The studies of solvent refined coal determined that some of the materials were toxic because of sulfur containing compounds in the naphtha or volatile fractions, primary aromatic amines in the mid-distillate non-volatile fractions and/or polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons in the upper range mid-distillate and heavy-end fractions. If any material remained, the volatile materials would have long since disappeared and the aromatic amines would have been degraded by sunlight or converted by soil microbes. The polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons were in low concentrations and would probably not be detectable due to the effects of rain and snow over the past 12 years.
