

Specific Issues Discussed at Meeting:

Public Involvement

No significant issues were identified at the February 1, 1994, Seattle Public Scoping meeting. The regulators requested copies of meeting transcripts and public comment letters; these are to be placed in the administrative record. The issue of who coordinates public comment response was raised. The DOE was identified as the responsible agency. Comment response format was identified as a generic letter with an attachment addressing specific comments. It was noted that during the TPA Annual and Quarterly meetings, it would be appropriate to have a DOE, EPA, or Ecology representative present to address comments.

An objective siting analysis of the 200 BC Control Area, conducted by Montgomery Watson, will address specific public concerns regarding siting of the ERDF. The study will address siting criteria, schedule impacts and additional costs incurred from moving the site. The suggestion was made to construct the initial facility at the current site and use the 200 BC Control Area as an expansion area. The regulators agreed that several configurations should be considered for ERDF. Discussion of these options will follow completion of the study, and would include:

- 200 BC Control Area as a site.
- 200 BC Control Area as primary site with expansion into Site 3.
- Site 3 as primary site with expansion into 200 BC Control Area.

The DOE is beginning to talk with the Indian Nations as part of Government to Government meetings. The DOE will invite the regulators to these meetings.

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Future public involvement activities will be discussed at the next regulatory interface meeting. Discussion will include specific activities and responsibilities which are required for the process.

Engineering Studies

Ecology requested that engineering studies included as Conceptual Design Report (CDR) appendices be provided for review at the earliest possible date. The regulators asked to be included in the review process from the start. The DOE indicated that the understanding was that concurrent review would happen with all documents, not just engineering documents. The DOE agreed to transmit all documents to the regulators for concurrent review. George Evans, Westinghouse Hanford Company, asked if this included the regulatory package. The DOE concurred.

Schedule Review

Regarding the CDR, the regulators will have three weeks for review and comment. Comment resolution will be completed by April 15, 1994. The EPA requested, due to schedule constraints, that a team be assembled to assist with ROD preparation.

Concurrent review will be used for all documents. By doing so, the regulators will be allowed six weeks to review the regulatory package.

Toxic Substance Control Act

Waste to be disposed in the ERDF may contain some Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) regulated PCBs. TSCA regulated substance must be disposed of in an EPA approved chemical waste landfill. The EPA responded that, if fulfillment of substantive TSCA requirements can be demonstrated at the ERDF, the DOE should not have to fulfill procedural requirements for obtaining a chemical waste landfill approval. The EPA committed to investigate DOE disposal of TSCA regulated PCBs in the ERDF.

Development of the Waste Acceptance Criteria

Preliminary Waste Acceptance Criteria (WAC) are included in the CDR. In order to coordinate WAC development, a meeting will be scheduled with the unit managers to discuss WAC development. The DOE agreed to schedule a meeting and provide ERDF WAC information to the unit managers. The EPA concerns at this time include moisture content, waste segregation, waste form and documentation.
