COMPLETION OF HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT) INTERIM MILESTONE M-016-250F

Reference: Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Change Control Form
M-16-21-01, TPA Interim Milestone M-016-250F, Three-Year Waste Site Schedule for
FY2022-2024, approved March 10, 2021

This letter documents completion of the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order (Tri-Party Agreement) Interim Milestone M-016-250F, "Submit to Ecology for approval a three year rolling prioritized schedule consistent with site-wide clean-up priorities to implement waste site removal actions per Action Memoranda (DOE/RL-2009-37, DOE/RL-2009-48, and DOE/RL-2009-86)" due March 31, 2021. The attached "Waste Site Fiscal Years 2022-2024," provides the required information to complete the milestone. It should be noted that no Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 commitments are being proposed at this time to allow other remediation strategies to mature. FY 2024 commitments will be reconsidered in the next submittal of the three-year rolling schedule. In addition, Change Control Form (CCF) M-16-21-01 documents the deletion of the Old Central Shop Area (OCSA) waste site from the M-016-259 milestone because the waste site crosses route 11A, an active roadway.

This milestone will continue on a yearly basis to reaffirm selected sites and recommend any changes to the list to maintain a three year rolling schedule, until such time that removal actions are completed.

The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office has worked with Kim Welsch of your staff, during the development of this document.
