
Administrative Record Documentation

Project Managers Agreement to identify the area for the complete TX Interim Surface Barrier, consistent with the three panel approach.

This document serves as record that the Washington State Department of Ecology and U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection, using the three panel approach approved in Agreement Record Accession #0066079H (EDMC#1248621) on March 20, 2018, has agreed to the extent of the remaining two interim surface barrier panels at the TX Tank Farm; the approximate coordinates for each of these panels captured in the table below. These locations are illustrated on Attachment A.
