Finding 00-01 documents the consensus of the voting representatives of the respective Trustee members on the PAD. Further, it affirms the Council's commitment to secure the approval of Member Trustee authorized officials, then convey or cause to be conveyed the PAD to DOE Richland.

According to Article VII of the bylaws, if you don't vote, that is counted as an abstention. You may also abstain with a separate opinion (see the bylaws and the signature form).

Remember, we are only saying that those of us around the table, the voting reps, have consensus on this issue. At Lowell, we'll talk about what our next steps need to be to get the consensus of our respective authorized officials.
