The Department of Energy proposes the construction and operation of six one-million gallon high-level radioactive waste tanks at Hanford with related waste retrieval and transfer systems.

The Department of Energy and the Washington Department of Ecology have prepared a draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) which addresses impacts from this construction and other reasonable alternatives. The DOE and Ecology are holding public hearings in Washington and Oregon to receive public comment on the draft EIS.
