**Description of current waste site condition:**

This site was cleaned up under 1100-IU-1 operable unit. Originally, the site was part of WIDS 600-116. In order to provide information related to the details of the cleanup, it was given its own site code. This form has been generated post "Deletion from the NPL".

**Basis for reclassification:**

The site was deleted from the NPL on 9/30/1996. The final closeout report, Superfund Site Final Closeout Report, documents that the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), under the oversight of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology), completed all construction activities for the Hanford 1100 Area in accordance with Procedures for Completion and Deletion of National Priority Sites (OSWER Directive 9320.2-3A) and updates thereto. EPA in conjunction with DOE, conducted the final inspection on December 12, 1995 and determined that the final remedial action had been successfully executed. Under 40 CFR Part 300, the notice of intent to Delete was published on August 15, 1996 in the Federal Register.
