State of the Site Thank You • Regional Public Involvement Opportunities

**Feedback State of the Site 2007 – Thank you** to those who participated in the 2007 Hanford State of the Site meetings. More than 300 members of the public turned out to the November and December meetings in Kennewick, Seattle, Portland and Hood River to discuss their issues, values and concerns. Some of the issues discussed with agency managers included worker health and safety, the cost and schedule for the Waste Treatment Plant, past tank leaks and tank integrity, waste transportation and possible offsite waste importation to Hanford, Tri-Party Agreement (TPA) commitments, and other US DOE initiatives. **In the coming months**, representatives from the TPA agencies plan to hold various regional public forums on issues such as selecting final cleanup alternatives for treatment, closure and waste disposal (Tank Closure and Waste Management Environmental Impact Statement), selecting cleanup alternatives for waste sites that have high levels of long-lived radionuclides, setting operational and closure requirements for key Hanford facilities.
