TRANSMITTAL OF THE 200-UP-2 OPERABLE UNIT FOCUSED FEASIBILITY STUDY (FFS),
DRAFT A, DOE/RL-95-106

Please find attached the subject document for your review. This transmittal fulfills the requirements of the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order (Tri-Party Agreement) Milestone M-15-15C, two and one-half months ahead of schedule. Please note that this draft was transmitted informally to the appropriate members of your staff during the week of February 5-9, 1996, in order for them to begin the review on February 12, 1996.

The 200-UP-2 Operable Unit includes the 216-U-12 Crib Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permitted Treatment, Storage, and Disposal unit. The closure/postclosure requirements for this unit have been incorporated into the FFS along with an updated Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act/RCRA coordination Matrix and Closure Plan Roadmap.
