This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

The site was a treatment facility for petroleum contaminated soil. Based upon analytical results of twelve soil samples, the cell meets the requirements for closure under WAC 173-340, provided that Ecology concurs with the rejection of the sample analysis for soil sample 607-SOILCELL-9.

Basis for reclassification:

Samples indicate no hazardous contamination. In August 2004, DOE sent a letter to the Washington State Department of Ecology, stating the corrective actions associated with this site had been completed.

Ecology will close out environmental liability under WAC 173-360 by separate letter.
