The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility (ERDF) regulatory package on June 17. This package contains the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study Report for the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility, DOE/RL-93-99, Rev. 0, the Proposed Plan for the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility at Hanford, Richland, Washington, DOE/RL-94-47, the Corrective Action Management Unit Application for the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility, DOE/RL-94-40, Rev. 0, and the NEPA Roadmap for the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility, DOE/RL-94-41, Rev. 0.

This letter serves to notify the Department of Energy (DOE) that we will be submitting comments on these documents by July 18. EPA believes that a comprehensive review of the "package" is necessary due to the technical complexity and sensitivity of the issues surrounding the ERDF. At the end of this review period EPA will make a determination of the adequacy of the package and will either direct the DOE to proceed with public comment or will notify the DOE of specific deficiencies necessary to complete the package.
