Dear Mr. McCormick:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received the Draft Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study Work Plan Addendum for the BC Cribs and Trenches Area Treatability Test. We have reviewed the document and have identified areas that need modification or additional clarification because it seems that some of our previous comments may have been misunderstood.

For example the work plan addendum states that EPA "concluded that insufficient data are available to select a remedial alternative." This statement is not accurate. Our position has been that removing the near surface contaminants and capping provides the highest degree of overall protection of human health and the environment, reduces the risk from principal threat waste more effectively, minimizes the reliance on institutional controls to protect against future exposures, and is consistent with stakeholder values as reflected in advice from the Hanford Advisory Board.

Rather than submitting formal comments at this time, we believe that working directly with your staff is the most efficient and timely approach to making these clarifications. It is our hope to meet with your staff and have this document finalized by February 16, 2007.
